

How to Save a Website as a Bookmark

Save a Website to Your Bookmarks

Saving a website as a favourite (also called a bookmark) lets you quickly find it again without having to type the web address.

Google Chrome

1. Open the website you want to save.
 2. Click the ★ star at the far right of the address bar.
 3. Choose where you would like to save it (e.g. **Bookmarks Bar** or **Other Bookmarks**).
 4. Click **Done**.
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Microsoft Edge

1. Open the website.
 2. Click the ★ star in the address bar.
 3. Give the bookmark a name if you'd like.
 4. Click **Done**.
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Safari (Mac)

1. Open the website.
 2. Click the **Share** button or choose **Bookmarks → Add Bookmark**.
 3. Select where to save it.
 4. Click **Add**.
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Firefox

1. Open the website.
2. Click the ★ star in the address bar.
3. The page is now bookmarked.
4. Click **Done**.

Finding Your Saved Favourites

Most browsers let you access your saved favourites by:

- Clicking the ★ or **Bookmarks** menu.
- Pressing **Ctrl + Shift + O** (Windows) or **Command + Option + B** (Mac) to manage bookmarks (browser dependent).
- Using the **Bookmarks Bar** if it is visible.
